The meeting was called to order by Ron Dinger, president, who welcomed all guests.

The budget report was given by Brian Churchman, CPA, director of resource management.

Brian Churchman discussed membership dues changes resulting from Census 2010. He showed a comparison of the dues for both 2000 and 2010 census results.

Ronnie Ward introduced staff member Susie Lindsey who discussed the re-codification process for cities and towns including steps involved in updating city/town ordinances.

J. C. Awtrey, trustee, advised federal funding had been eliminated for all Resource, Conservation and Development agencies and, as such, Chisholm Trail RC&D Council would no longer receive federal funds.

Dan Lowrance, director of Delta Senior Nutrition, updated the trustees on the nutrition site programs in this area.

Brian Churchman advised there will be a two percent cut for all federal grants. Some grant programs will receive a larger cut. State funding is still contingent on a budget being approved.

Ken Jones, director of supportive services, advised that there is a bill in the state legislature that would reduce the number of state area agency on aging from 11 to six. He advised we are watching this bill closely.
