

AIM Required Fields that must be entered to address Oklahoma's missing data

Congregate meals, Nutrition Counseling, and Assisted Transportation services must have:

Age, Gender, Rural, Poverty, Live Alone, Ethnicity, and Race

Home Delivered meals, Chore, Case Management, and Homemaker services must have:

Age, Gender, Rural, Poverty, Live Alone, Ethnicity, Race, and ADLS

Caregiver and Grandparent services must have:

Age, Gender, Rural, Ethnicity, Race, and Relationship

Caregiver and grandparent services

Data entry must have Unduplicated Person Served data in AIM for *Counseling, Training, Support Groups, Respite and Supplemental Services*. This means an assessment must be created on everyone for these services to address the age, gender, rural, ethnicity, race and relationship, including caregivers under the age of 60 and grandchildren.

Caregiver and Grandparent Information about Assistance services must have a group activity built and an estimated number of audience members notated. Information about Services cannot be entered as a state aggregate unit.

Caregiver and Grandparent Access to services must have at least the minimum data set of name, date of birth, age, gender, rural, ethnicity, race and relationship for an estimated unduplicated count.
