## ARE YOUR CODE BOOKS IN COMPIANCE WITH STATE LAW?

11 O.S. Section 14,109 requires municipalities to compile publish their and penal ordinances in a permanent form every ten years. It also requires municipality the to publish biennial (every other year) supplements for any changes to codebooks' the penal ordinances. 11 O.S. Section 14.111.E states that no municipality may levy a fine (or deferral fee in lieu of a fine) of over \$50 until the municipality has compiled and published the ordinances as required. If your municipality is not in compliance with the law, please contact SUSIE LINDSAY in ASCOG's economic community and development division. She can help you get your ordinances compiled and published.
