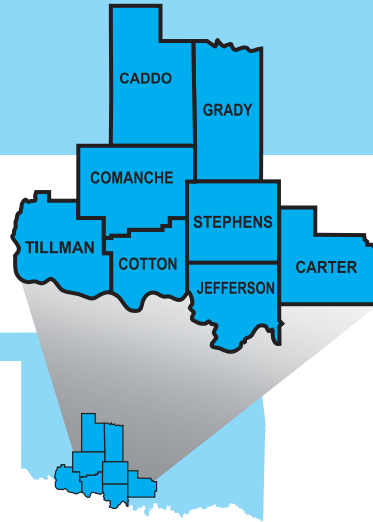

MANAGED CARE ADVANTAGE SERVICES

ELIGIBILITY:

To receive ADvantage services a person must meet the following requirements:

- Be 65 years or older and frail, or
- Be 21 years or older and be disabled without a diagnosis of developmental disability or cognitive impairment
- Meet financial guidelines
- Require the level of services provided in a nursing home
- Require services that are below the cost of a nursing home

All services are free of charge.

THE ADVANTAGE PROGRAM CAN PROVIDE SERVICES SUCH AS:

Meals

Light housekeeping

Laundry

Shopping and errands

Medication management

Transportation referrals

Emergency Response System

Durable medical equipment

Bathing assistance

Safety Supervision

Other assistance as determined necessary to meet your needs.
